William Price, the son of Michael Price and Mary Elizabeth Evans was born on November 21, 1803. According to the 1880 Federal Census report, his parents are immigrants from Wales to Virginia. His trade was that of a farmer with a real estate value of \$8,000. He was a delegate to the 2nd Wheeling Convention. His wife, Catharine dies in April 27, 1869 and leaves William with the care of ten children: George, Abraham B., Elisabeth, Mary, John E., Jeremiah O., Albert C., Maria L., Thomas H., Christina J. His dies on May 14, 1881.
