ON THIS DAY IN WEST VIRGINIA HISTORY JANUARY 7



On January 7, 1860, the Virginia General Assembly passed an act compensating \$1,500 to state attorney Andrew Hunter of Charles Town, Jefferson County, for his legal services in prosecuting John Brown and his raiders.

Describe the effect of John Brown's Raid and how it coincided with increasing sectional tensions prior to the Civil War.
